3. Department is led by a teacher who has received the best teacher award in University, a person with 39 years of teaching experience and a renowned writer who has received Kendra Sahitya Academy Award.
4. Only PG department in sociology under government sector in the university.
5. Conducting innovative programs like Swatch Bharath-Swasth Bharath, induction program and active participation in welfare programs.

Weaknesses:

1. It is one of the youngest departments which has to procure sufficient infrastructure.
2. It runs under the self-financing centre of the university and is not yet supported by government and UGC.
3. Teachers are appointed on a contract scheme and lack permanent teachers.
4. Not eligible for any UGC support as it is under a self-financing scheme.
5. Department library with sufficient research journals has to be procured.

2. Department can be developed as the first research department in sociology under Calicut University.
