8. Does the P. G Programme curriculum focus on employability?

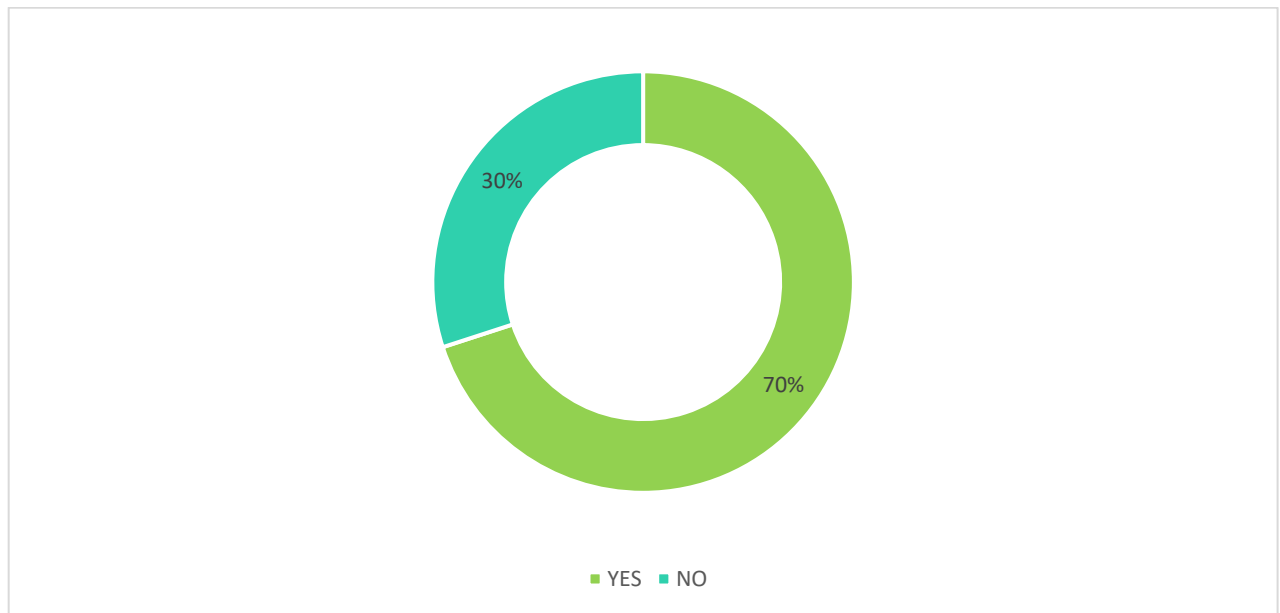

2136 alumni participated in the survey

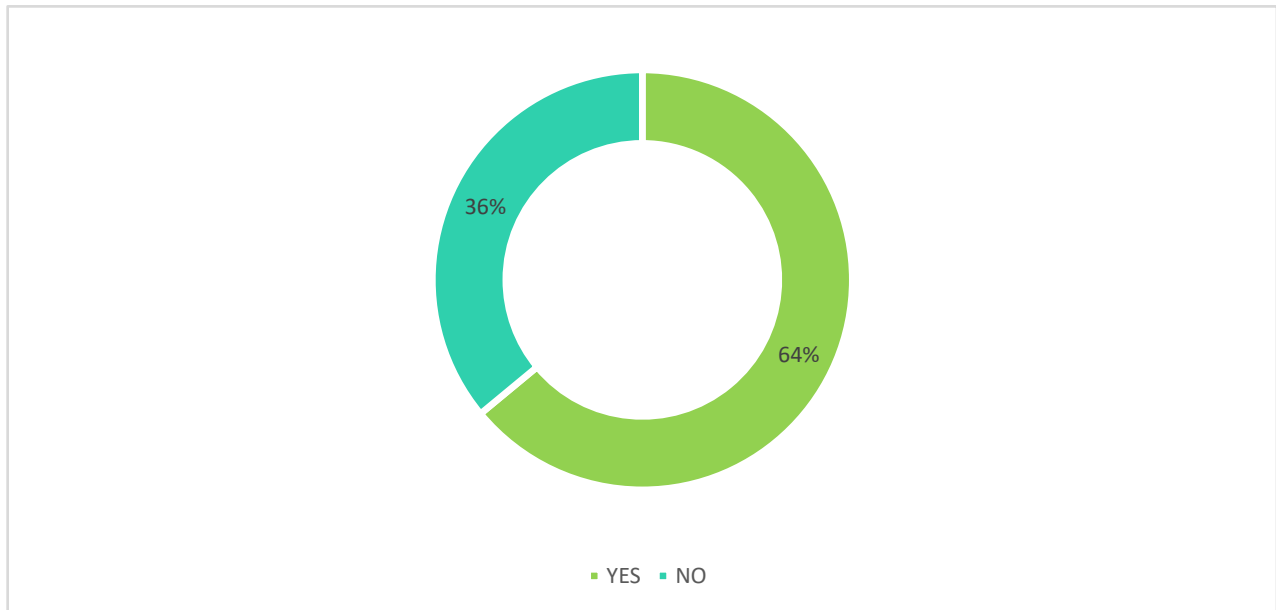
The respondents are from the pass out batches of different streams of P. G Programme

1. Did the program curriculum intellectually stimulate?



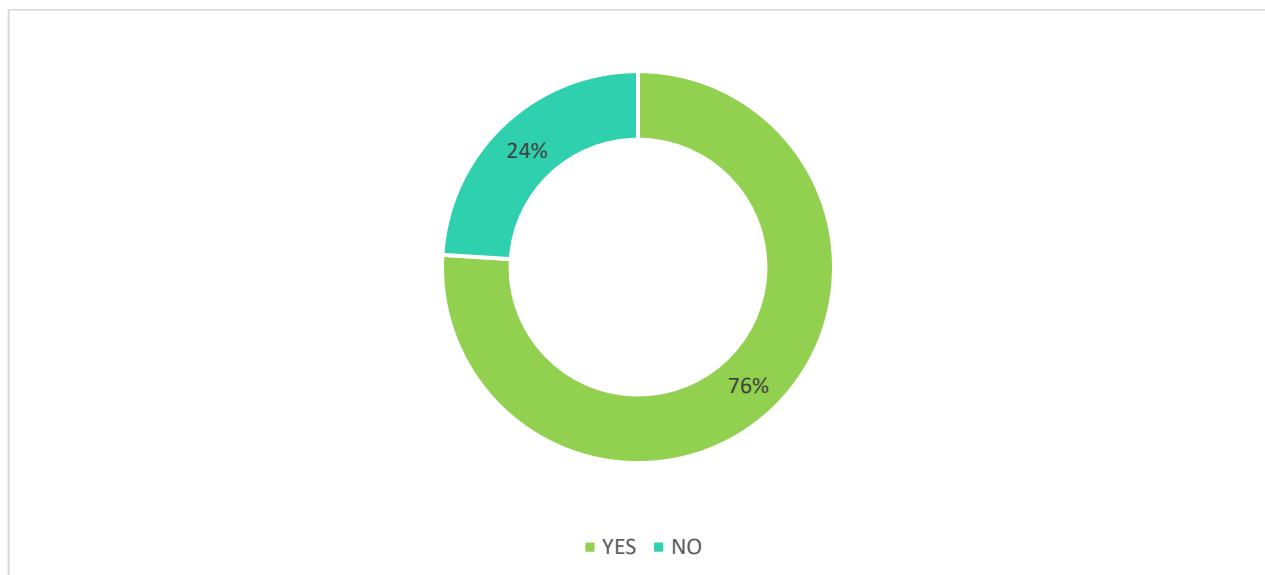
70 percent of the respondent have rated that the curriculum of the programme offered by the university intellectually stimulate the students whereas 30 percent of them disagree with it.

2. Did the program curriculum fulfil your expectations?



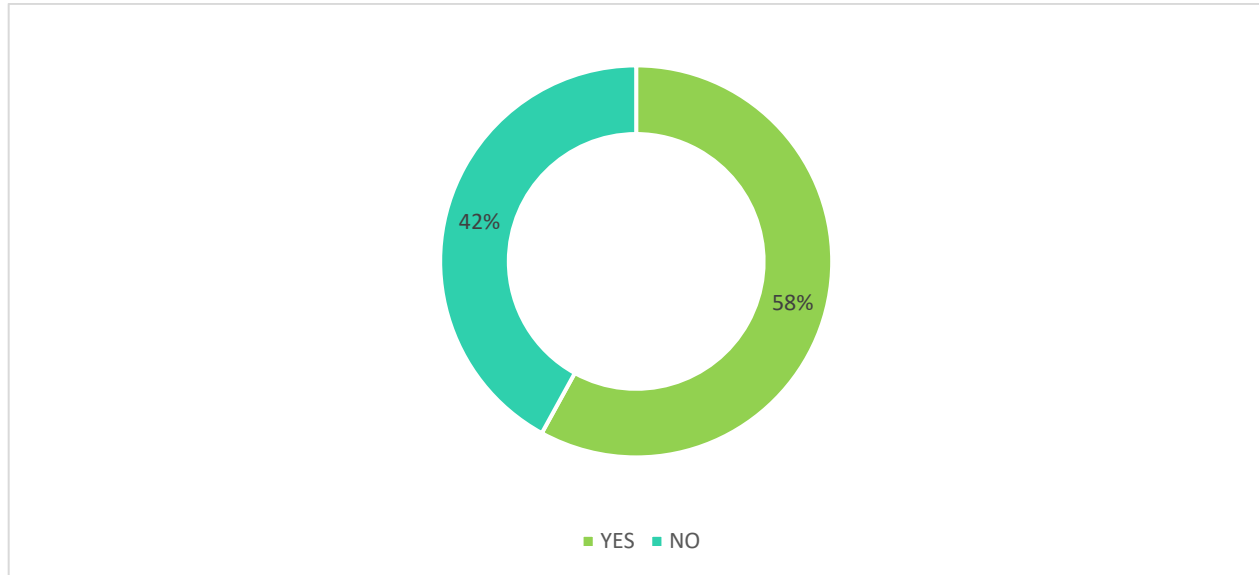
64 percent of the Alumni said that the curriculum of the P. G programme fulfilled their expectations while 36 percent of the remaining respondents responded as it failed to meet their expectations.

3. Did the curriculum of the P. G Programme useful for higher education?



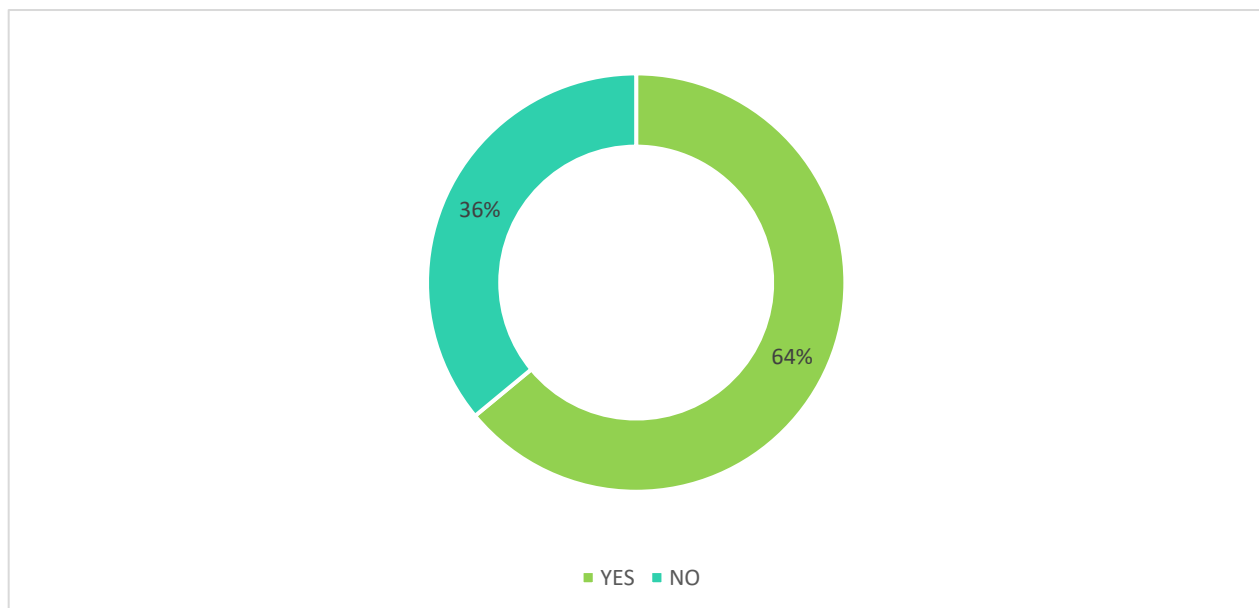
76 percent of respondents expressed that the curriculum of the P. G Programme is useful for their higher education however, the rest of the 24 percent disagreed with it

4. Did the curriculum of the P. G Programme focus on multidisciplinary aspects?



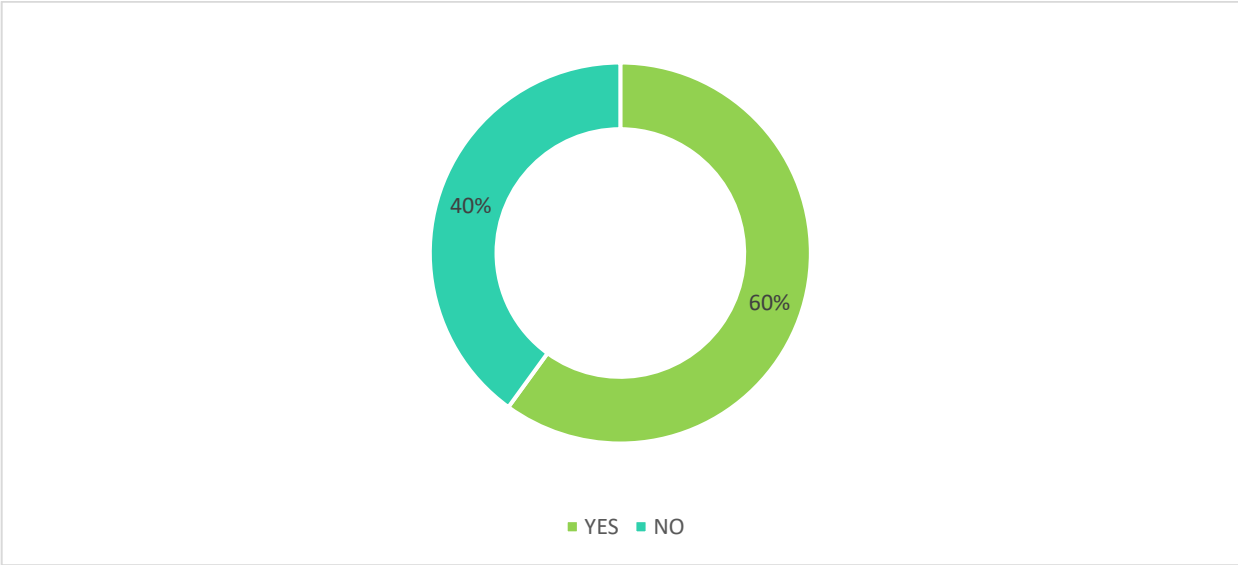
58 percent of the Alumni responded positively on the focus of multidisciplinary aspects in curriculum, whereas the remaining respondents, 42 percent, have given a negative reply.

5. Did the curriculum of the P. G Programme focus on research?



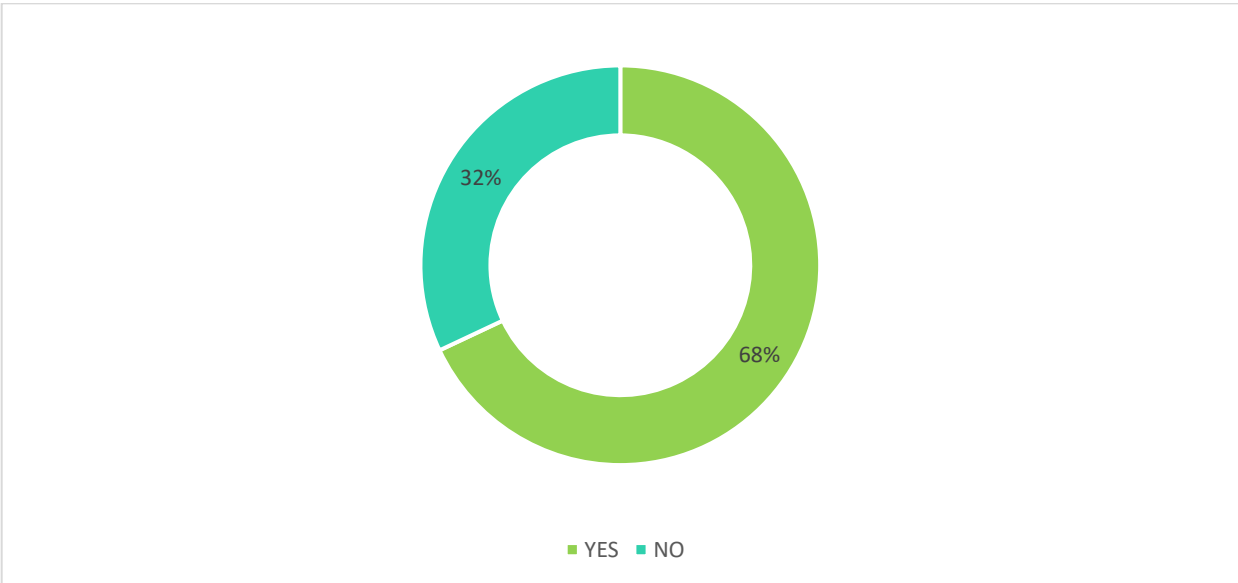
64 percent of the respondents replied to this question in a positive manner while the rest of the 36 percent of the Alumni disagree with it.

6. Have you attained any new skill from the program?



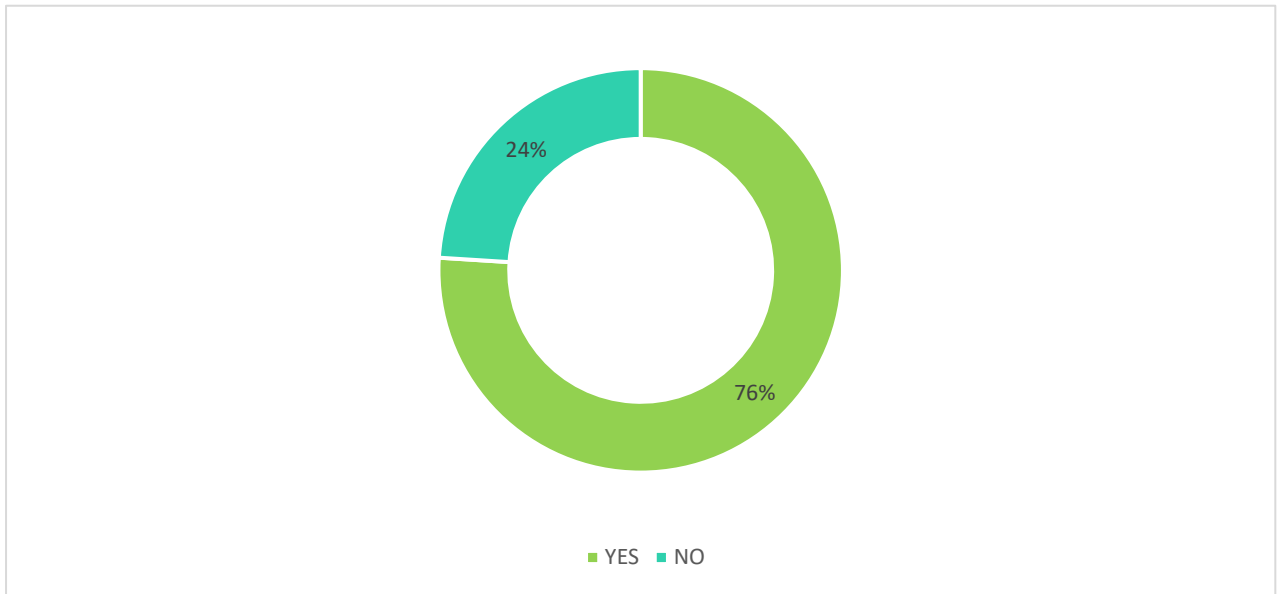
60 percent of the Alumni expressed that they have attained some sort of new skill from the programme, but 40 percent of the remaining respondents failed to agree with it

7. Did the subject/ program help in developing your personality?



68 percent of the respondents replied that the curriculum of their P. G programmed helped them in developing their personality, whereas the remaining 32 percent of the Alumni responded it witha disagreement.

8. Does the program focus on employability?



76 percent of the Alumni expressed that the curriculum of their P. G Programme is focusing on their employability and career planning but the rest of the 24 percent of respondents think that it is not focusing on employability.
