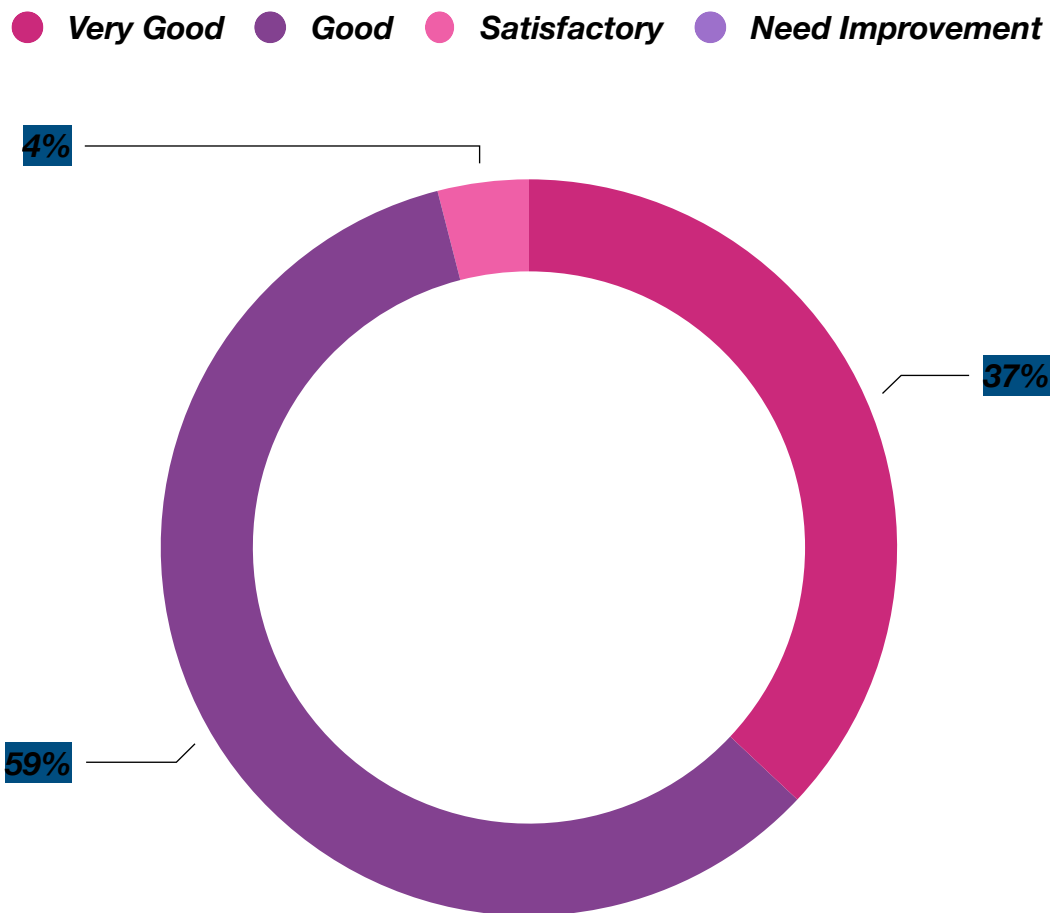

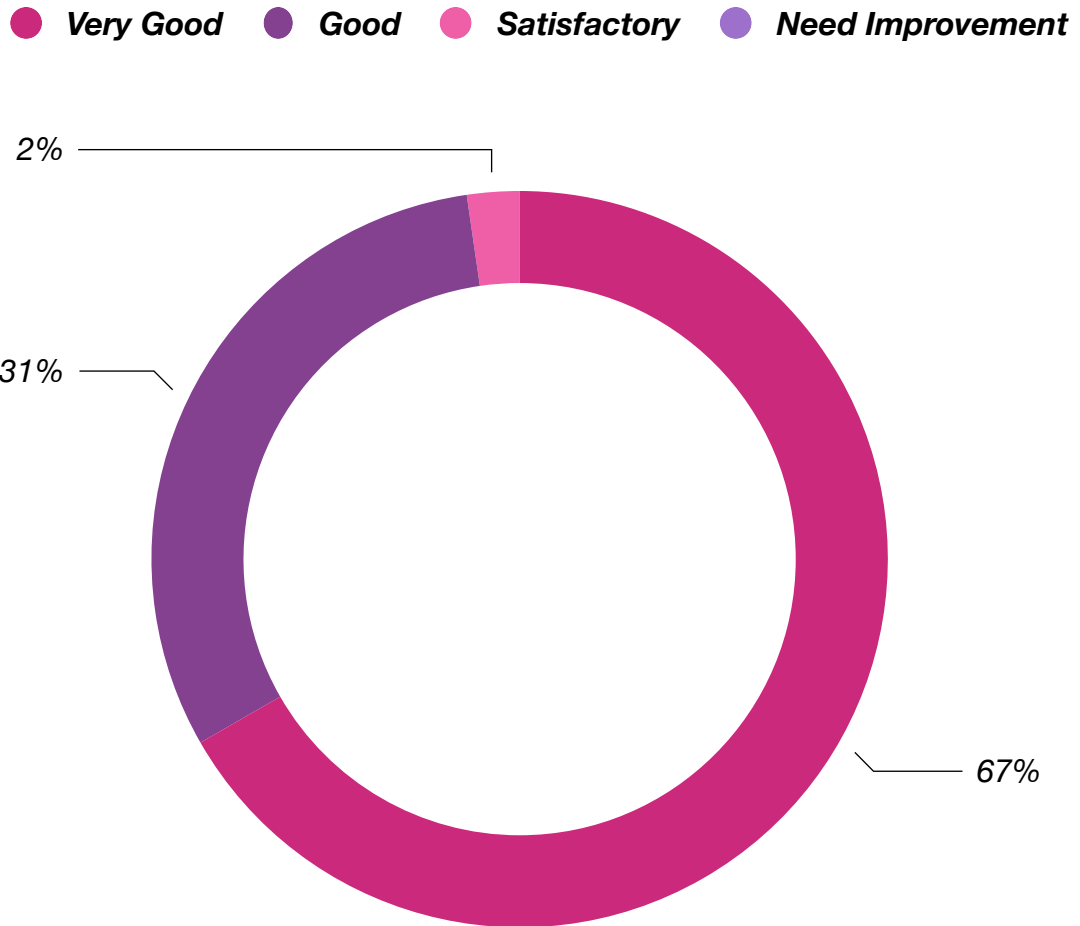

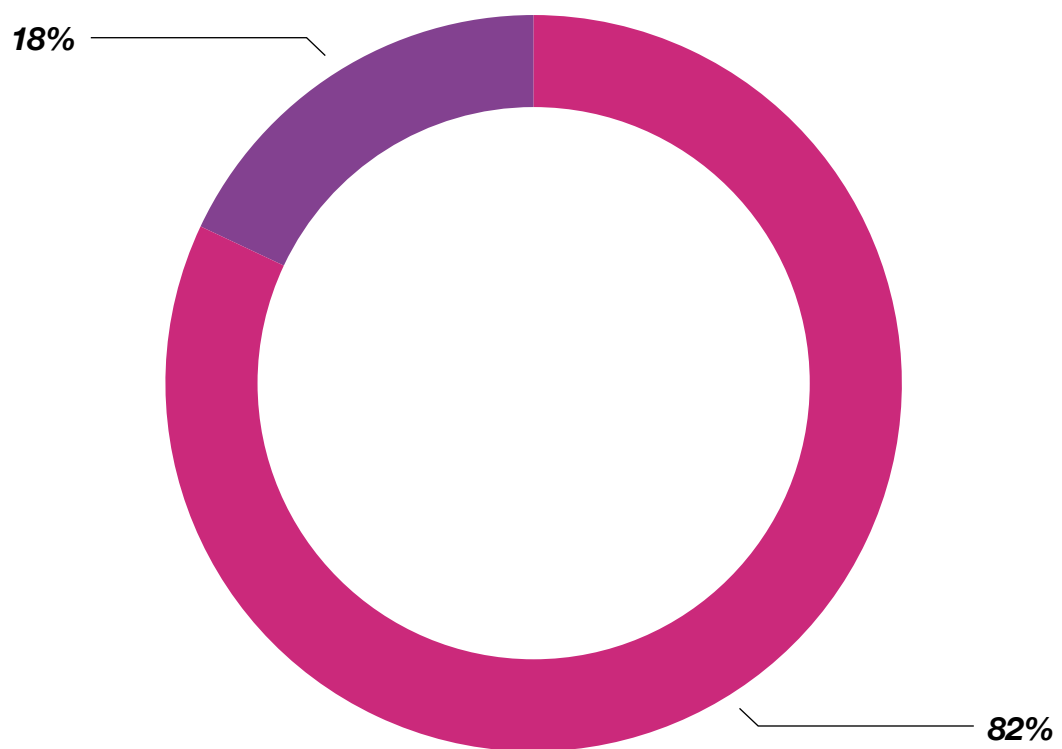
2. How do you rate the adequacy of curriculum?

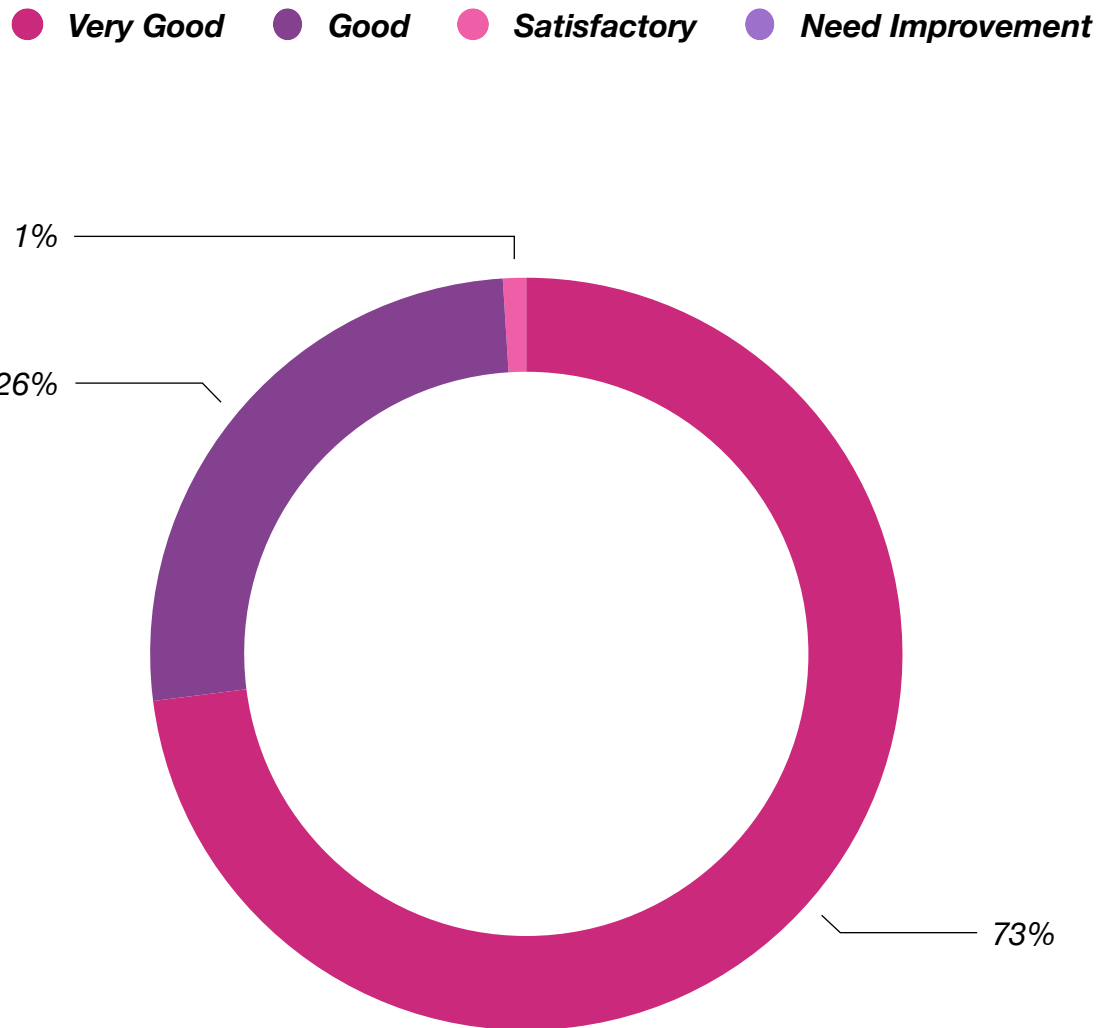
3. How do you rate the competency level of our student(s) in relation to course content?

82% of the respondents rated the competency level of our student(s) in relation to course content as very good whereas 18% of the respondents marked it as good.

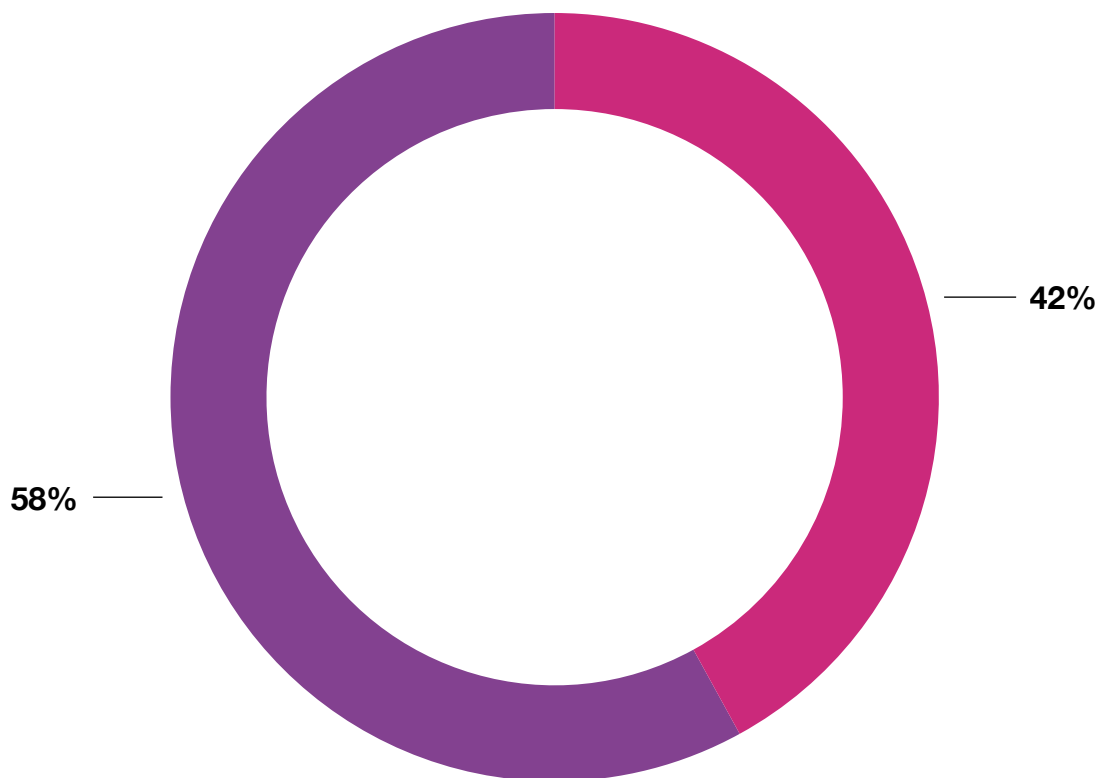
4. How do you rate the subject knowledge of our student(s)working with you in relation to the Programme Curriculum?

5. How do you rate the proficiency of our student(s) working with you?

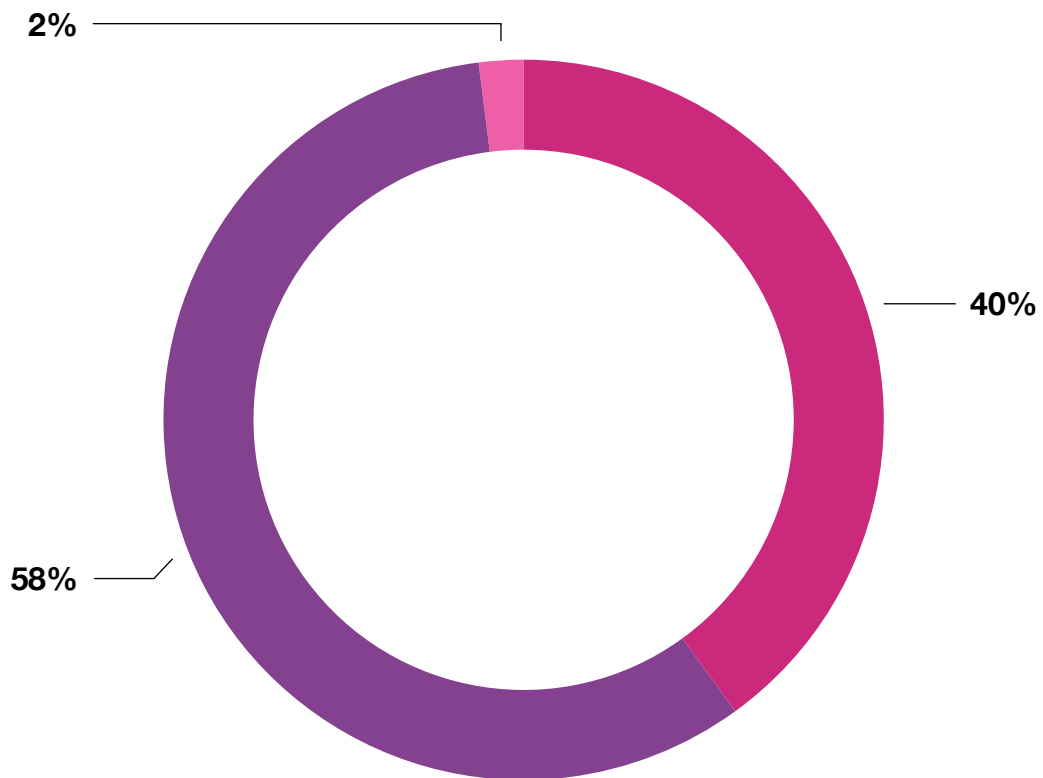

6. How do you rate the communication skill/research aptitude of our students(s) working with you?

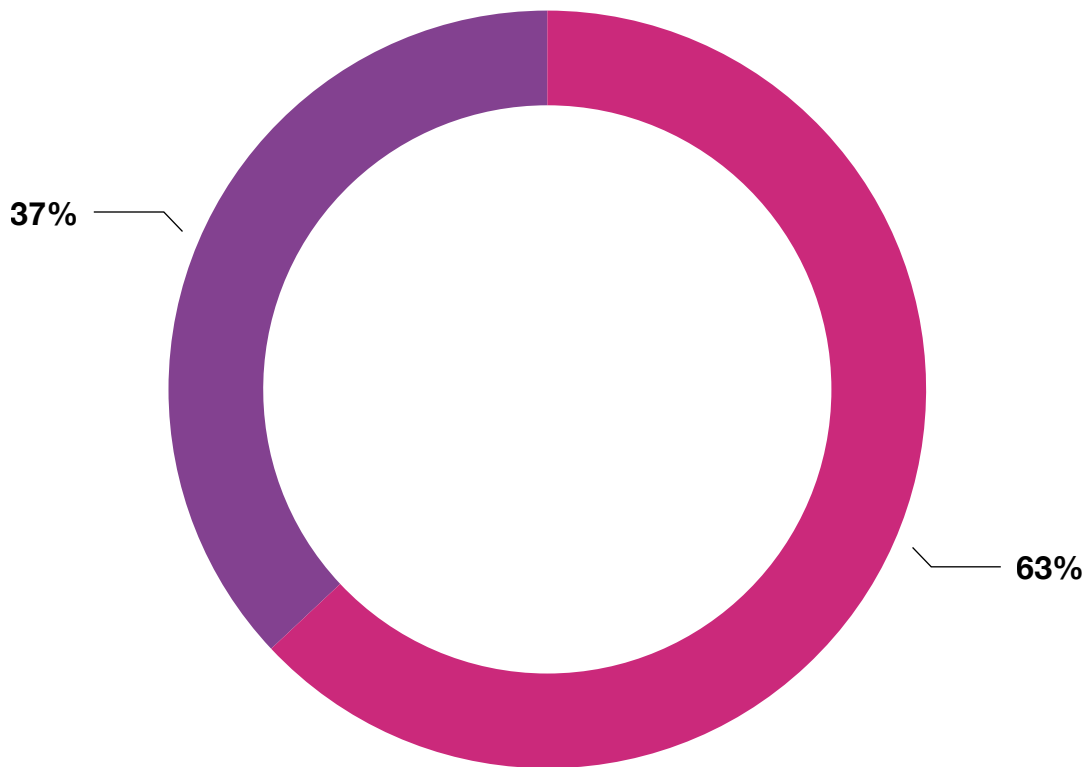
● *Very Good* ● *Good* ● *Satisfactory* ● *Need Improvement*
